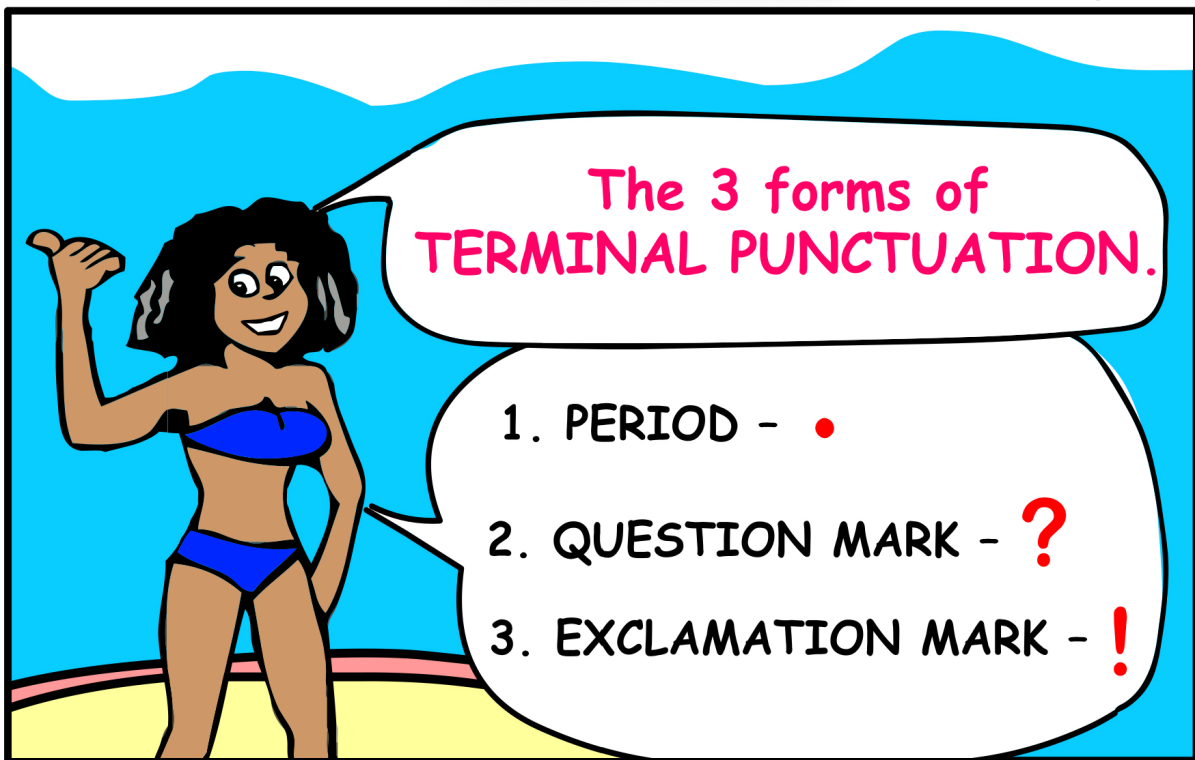

?

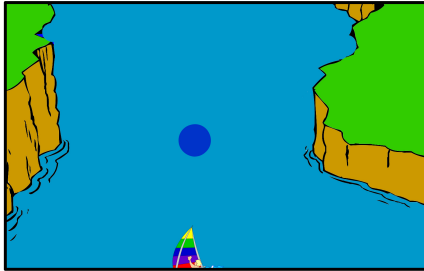
= question mark

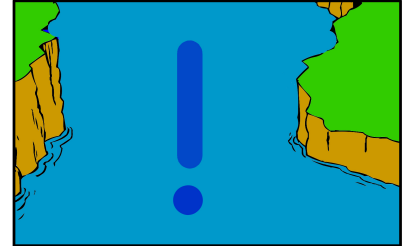

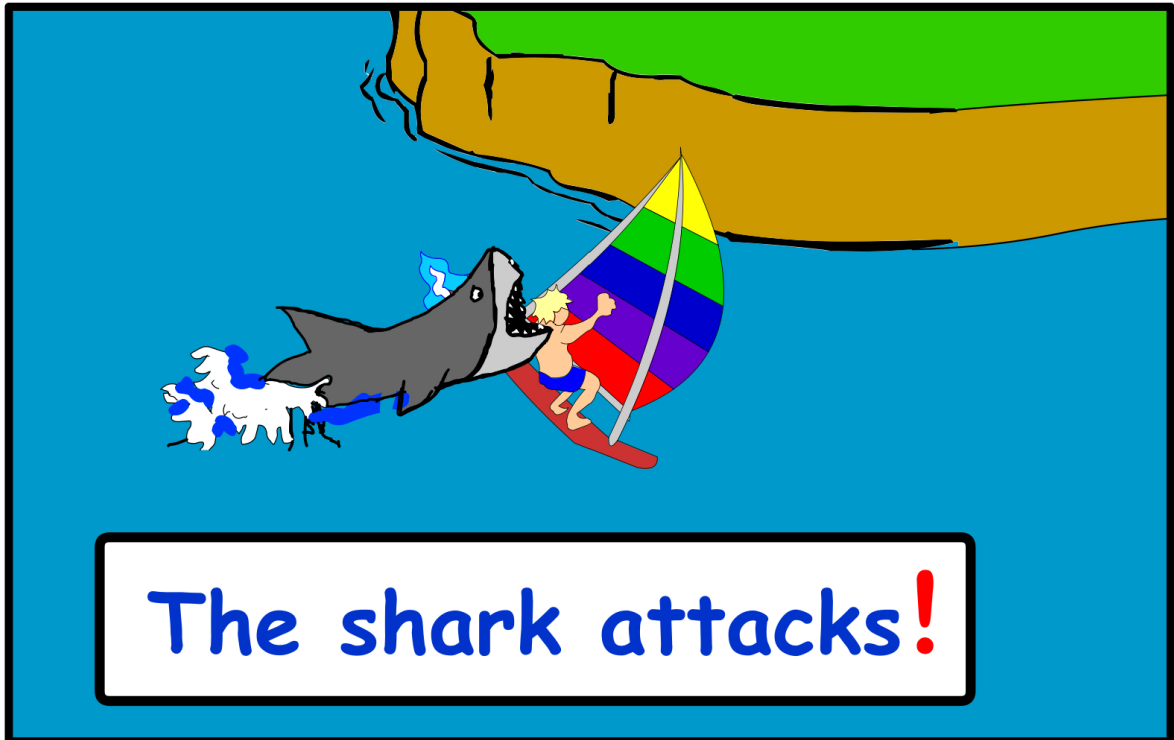
